What we ask from Weed Watchers:

- **Contact Information:**
 - *Email address for updates and Weed Report follow-up*
 - *Street Address of home or office so we can map our coverage area*
 - *County that you live or work in and any other areas that you may notice invasive species.*
- *The ability to identify a few invasive species and recognize possible new or dangerous infestations.*
- *The willingness to keep your eyes open for invasive plant infestations during your normal work, travel, and recreation.*
- *The willingness to report potential invasive species infestations via a simple online reporting system at www.SICWMA.org, or via phone at 1-866 NO EXOTIC (1-866-663-9684).*

What Weed Watchers get in return:

- *The satisfaction of helping to reduce the environmental and economic damage caused by invasive species in your community.*
- *An email confirmation that each of your weed reports has been received and will be acted upon.*
- *Training and/or resource materials to help you recognize potential invasive species.*
- *Ongoing communication via email and our website with information about recognizing particular invasive species at different times of the year.*
- *Recognition and awards for outstanding Weed Watcher performance.*
- *Annual weed watcher workshops with the opportunity to give feedback about the project, talk with other Weed Watchers, and learn more about invasive species.*
- *A Weed Watcher badge, button or other cool accessories to identify you as a Weed Watcher.*

Weed Watcher Etiquette:

- **Safety First!!!!** *Always drive safely and keep your eyes on the road. Always have a designated driver if you are Weed Watching from your vehicle!!*
- **No Trespassing:** *Weed Watchers should never trespass on Private Property. You can Weed Watch on public land or get permission from private landowners first.*
